HELENA, Feb. 8.—Through the incisive action of Chief of Police Tracy and Coroner Yeager the mystery surrounding the death of Mary Rodgers, 17 years old, who was killed in Helena, has been cleared away. The coroner's verdict has been rendered and it is the most important feature of the case. It is the first time that a girl had died from an operation, reported by an operation. 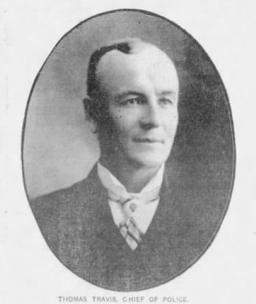
